Edward Tyler Nahem Fine Art to Exhibit Four Decades of Pop at Art Basel Hong Kong 2015

For their inaugural presentation at Art Basel Hong Kong (March 15-17), Edward Tyler Nahem Fine Art will feature major works by Pop Art masters. Significant works by Jean-Michel Basquiat, Keith Haring, Roy Lichtenstein, and Andy Warhol will be exhibited. According to Nahem "Beginning with Lichtenstein and Warhol's pioneering achievements with Pop Art in the late 1950s and 1960s and continuing to the next generation of this idiom with the unique voices of Basquiat and Haring, each of these artists in his own right has significantly altered or enhanced the understanding and appreciation of art as we know it."

Nahem will present key examples of Warhol's portraits of Mao Tse-Tung, Joseph Beuys, and a seminal Jackie Kennedy from 1964. A complete portfolio of Warhol's beloved flower screenprints from the Seventies will be displayed alongside a dramatic stainless steel work by Lichtenstein from the Nineties. Haring will be represented by Eighties era works in an array of mediums including a large-scale acrylic on vinyl tarpaulin. This particular painting has been included in numerous important exhibitions of Haring's work during the ensuing decades, most recently at the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris in 2013. Prominent in the gallery's stand will be major works on paper by Basquiat alongside a prime 1983 work on canvas. A rare and important painting, this work has been in a private collection for almost two decades and features the distinctive exposed wooden support characteristic of this period.

Edward Tyler Nahem Fine Art will be located at Stand 3D33 at Art Basel Hong Kong.

Established in New York in 1985, Edward Tyler Nahem Fine Art has built an international reputation for exhibiting exceptional Modern, Post-War, and Contemporary works of art. The gallery stages monographic and thematic exhibitions at its base on 57th Street, participates in art fairs internationally, and also has representatives in Miami and Madrid. Edward Tyler Nahem Fine Art works with private individuals, museums, and corporations to build focused and inspired collections.
